Dear Parents/Guardians:

Last night at the Governor Wentworth Regional School Board meeting, action was taken by the Board to set the last day of school for June 21, 2018.

The discussion took place due to the high number of cancelled school days resulting from emergency days or inclement weather this year. Based on the current calendar, if the District has more cancellations this winter, the last day could have potentially been moved to the last week in June. The Board does not want a late end to the school year to impact students who will be attending summer camp, starting summer jobs or families who have planned vacations that week. The Board agreed to an administrative proposal that if the District has an additional snow day, or days, the instructional time will be made up by adding 15 minutes per day until the equivalent in instructional time for the day, or days, is reached. Should we have additional cancellations, time will be added to the school day as follows:

One cancellation: add 15 minutes to the end of the school day March 5th-April 6th

Two cancellations: add 15 minutes to the end of the school day April 9th-May 17th

Three cancellations: add 15 minutes to the end of the school day May 18th -June 21st

By specifying the last day of school, parents are able to plan their summer schedule and students are able to secure summer employment. The last day of school, June 21st, will be a full day for students and staff.
